

Athletic Advisory Committee

“The Athletic Advisory Committee is comprised of members of the LSCC faculty and staff that serve for one academic year. These members are recommended by the Director of Athletics and appointed by the President. The Committee meets twice per semester and reviews: proposed policies and procedures for the Athletic department, current and new sport offerings, issues related to student-athletes, and yearly athletic events. The committee assists in making recommendations and proposed changes to the Director of Athletics, for approval by the President of LSCC.”

Student Athletic Committee

The Director of Athletics will recruit student volunteers to serve on an advisory committee for the intercollegiate athletic department. This committee will be comprised of two student representatives from the Student Government Association, one representative from student life, one student-athlete from each intercollegiate sports team, and three additional students from the general student population. The Student Athletic Committee will review recommendations concerning the Student-Athlete Handbooks, assist in the design and choice of team uniforms, serve as a sounding board for the students and make recommendations for the special events during home contests. - **Student employment opportunities in the Athletic Department. These positions are offered through the Financial Aid office, for students that qualify for work study or student assistant positions.**
