**It's Not Too Early to Think about
Lake-Sumter Community College's Fall Classes**

LEESBURG (June 30, 2009) - The last of Lake-Sumter Community College's summer terms has just started with record-breaking enrollment. Fall classes also will be in great demand, so it is important that new students start the enrollment process early for the best selection of courses and schedules.

LSCC's fall term begins August 24 and continues through December 12. Online registration for current LSCC students begins on July 6 for those with 45 or more credit hours and on July 13 for students with 44 or fewer credit hours. The fall class schedule is available on LSCC's website at www.lsc.edu.

Open registration for new students, or those who have not taken a course in over a year, starts on July 20. Prior to registering, new students need to complete several steps listed on the website under "Future Students," then "Enrollment Steps." Completion of the admissions application and placement testing, as well as attending a New Student Orientation should be completed early to be ready to register starting July 20.
